Peasant Bistro offers a warm, inviting atmosphere. Overlooking Centennial Park and the Atlanta skyline, the lush two-story space boasts a dramatic staircase and a neutral color scheme with pops of artwork. Chef Michael Patria's country French and Mediterranean-influenced menu includes delicious French onion soup, lamb tagine, foie gras, braised short ribs and a daily risotto. Whatever you do, don't miss all-you-can-eat mussels on Monday nights. Served with one of three broths—au nage, Provençal and curry—and lots of crusty bread for dipping, it's available for \$15 or \$25 with a bottomless glass of house wine.
