You’ll find that famous cocktail plus the festive spirit and flavorful cuisine of New Orleans at Redfish a Creole Bisto—the new venture by Jack Sobel, founder of Agave Restaurant, and Gregg Herndon, founder of Tiburon Grille—in historic Grant Park. The décor blends stereotypic Mardi Gras beads and wrought ironwork with contemporary touches for classy results. The full-service bar offers an extensive wine list with beers (including Abita) and cocktails (including the Hurricane). But the main attraction is the authentic, well-executed assortment of Creole, Cajun, and Acadian cuisine. Don’t miss Gregg’s Gumbo (\$7), an exquisite version of the New Orleans classic. Here, the only storm brewing is the buzz the place is likely to attract.



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
